Born 1936 in Düsseldorf (Germany). 1961 Ph.D. in philosophy, University of Erlangen. 1970-2005 Professor of Philosophy at the University of Constance, since 1990 also Director of the Center for Philosophy of Science. 1985-1990 Member of the German Science Council; 1992-1997 Member of the Senate of the German Research Society; 1993-1999 Member (founding member) of the German-American Academic Council (Bonn/Washington D.C.); 1995-1998 Member of the German Chancellor's Council for Research, Technology, and Innovation; since 2005 Chairman of the Austrian Science Council (Vienna). 1997-1999 President of the German Philosophical Association; 2002-2007 President of the Academia Europaea (London). 1989 Leibniz Prize of the German Research Society; 1998 Lorenz Oken Medal of the Society of German Scientists and Physicians; 1999 Officer's Cross of the Order of Merit of the Federal Republic of Germany.
